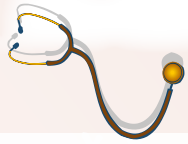

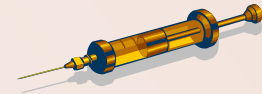

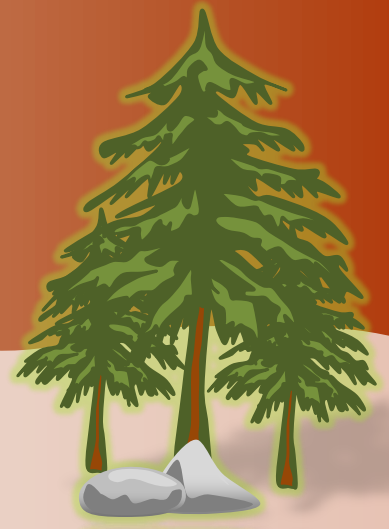
Congratulations Members of the Month!

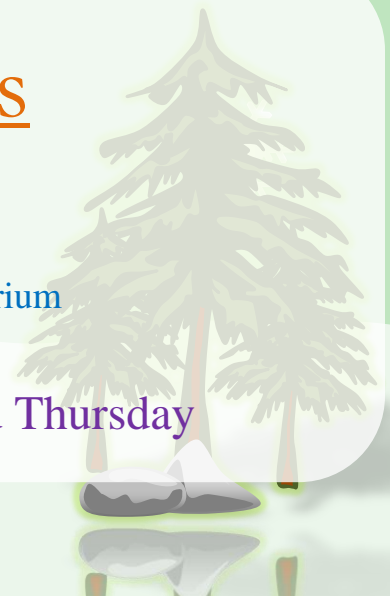
